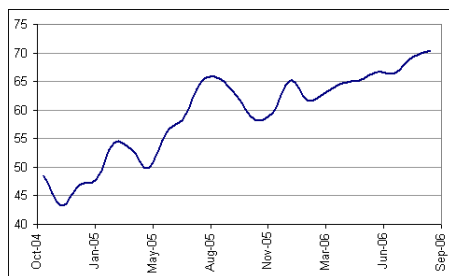
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Crude Reality

It is expected that HM Revenue & Customs will amend the list of vehicles permitted to use rebated fuel. The tractor/agricultural and mobile crane categories will be reworded and the road construction vehicle category will be removed.

Biofuels Breakthrough:

A surge in the use of Biofuels is predicted as HM Revenue & Customs have cut duty by 20p/lit. A cut was originally refused on vegetable oil, as it had not been produced for use in diesel engines. Further announcements will be made shortly.
